

Generic D'Link Router

Fibre Connection & VLAN on.

(This guide should be suitable for most of the DIR series of D'Link routers. E.g., DIR-2150, DIR-853, DIR-1260 etc.)

Log into the router's settings page

1. Connect your device (Phone, computer, or tablet) to the router. Either by Ethernet cable or by connecting to the Wi-Fi. It might be labelled "D'Link XXXX".
2. Open a web browser on the connected device (e.g. Chrome, Safari or Firefox). In the address bar (or search bar) type: **dlinkrouter.local/** or **192.168.0.1**. Like below:



3. Once you have logged in, if it is your first time logging in, it will prompt you to set a new Admin password. Please set this to something you'll remember in case we need to log back in. *(If this is not the case, you may need to factory reset the router, this can be done by holding the 'reset' button on the back of the router for 10 secs and then releasing it).*

Add the correct connection settings

1. Once you have set the Password, you'll be presented with an option for the 'Quick Setup'. You can do this; however, you won't be able to change the **VLAN** settings needed for the connection. We recommend going/skipping to the 'Home' screen. Up the top of the screen, you should see an option labelled **Settings**. Under this, there should be an option labelled **Internet**.
2. Select **IPV4**.
3. Select **PPPoE** as the connection type.
4. The Username and Password need to be set to: **Your NOW Account Number**.
5. Reconnect Mode: **Always On**
6. Maximum Idle Time: **Leave as Default**
7. Click **Save**
8. Once you have saved the settings, it may take you back to the Home screen. Click back into **Settings > Internet**. Under Internet you should see an option labelled **VLAN**.
9. Enable **Triple-Play Status**
10. Just enable **Internet VLAN** (not IPTV or VOIP VLAN)
11. VLAN Tag: **Enabled**
12. Internet VLAN ID: **10**
13. Priority: **0**
14. Click **Save**

You should now be able to connect to the internet. How good!

VLAN Settings

Internet

A Triple-Play (VLAN) is a switched network that is logically segmented by function, project team, or application, without regard to the physical location of the users. You can configure which hardware port will be assigned to a VLAN, and all packets from a network device in a VLAN will only be forwarded to other devices in the same VLAN.
